## THE VISION

Since 1994 when Jon and Peta Nott purchased the site of what is now Rose Gums Wilderness Retreat, they had a goal of converting the once degraded dairy farm into a rainforest paradise. The couple wanted to put into practice their strong environmental values and they have been more than successful in this pursuit.

## THE BUSINESS

Over the past 15 years, owners Jon and Peta Notts have transformed the Rose Gums Wilderness Retreat into a successful ecotourism accommodation provider.

The retreat offers treehouse accommodation in a private rainforest setting that include full equipped kitchens, large spa baths and wood fireplace. The retreat sources its water from a spring and has an in-house restaurant.

They actively engage guests in their passion for energy efficiency through education and have implemented various initiatives resulting in significant energy cost savings.

## CHALLENGES

### Option Availability:

Due to the lack of sunny days and high winds, both solar and wind energy was not a viable option for the property and required the owners to have a more creative approach in saving energy.

## ENERGY EFFICIENT ACHIEVEMENTS

### Energy Efficient Fixtures:

Rose Gums Wilderness Retreat has implemented energy efficient fixtures in various areas of the accommodation.

### INITIATIVES:

Installation of gas hot water units, using 5-star instantaneous units and cooking facilities.

Installation of eco-efficient lighting and appliances.



## HOW TO DO IT:

### Gas Hot Water Systems

## USING EFFICIENT DESIGN

### Energy Efficient Design:

Rose Gums Wilderness Retreat has incorporated energy efficient design to reduce the need for energy usage.

#### INITIATIVES:

Passive solar design was incorporated into the treehouses (e.g. orienting treehouses to capture light).

## HOW TO DO IT:

### Solar Passive Design

- Install shading devices over glass windows
- Insulate your building
- Glaze windows
- Install skylights

## PROMOTING ENERGY EFFICIENCY

### Engaging guests:

Rose Gums Wilderness retreat is proud of their energy efficiency achievements and promotes these achievements to guests.

#### INITIATIVES:

Guests have the opportunity to partake in carbon offsetting by planting a rainforest tree on the property and receive a certificate detailing the resulting carbon credits, followed by yearly reports on tree plantings.

## HOW TO DO IT:

### Promoting Energy Efficiency

You can easily promote your energy efficiency efforts through various avenues including:

- **Give a tour** of your energy efficiency initiatives to guests and encourage them to take part in activities.
- **Give guests a memento** to share with their friends to show their contribution to energy saving at the business.



#### Piece of Advice:

Owners Jon and Peta Nott stress the importance of measuring and assessing your energy efficiency and seeking the advice of an independent auditor. Jon and Peta also encourage operators to recognize the skills of current employees, who are likely to have valuable input.

## THE FUTURE

Rose Gums Wilderness Retreat has improved their energy efficiency immensely since beginning on their journey and plan to continue their efficiency efforts by implementing the following;

- Replacing the older hot water storage units with 5-star units;
- Investigating a ram system to pump water from the creek which is 100m lower than the water tanks to save on electricity.
